

- 1. In 1952 this 100 year old company was having cash flow issues, so they turned to an outside source to help with development of a new model. The company was Studebaker.
- 2. Studebaker reached across the pond to a company that had been formed in 1931 as "designers and consultants for land, sea and air vehicles". That company was Porsche. (Of course you already knew that, I'm sure.) To this day, Porsche still consults; they were instrumental in helping Harley Davidson develop the engine for their V-Rod.
- 3. When Porsche presented the Type 542 in South Bend, Studebaker's Director of Experimental Engineering was highly critical of everything about the prototype that was European. That engineer was John Z. Delorean; yep, *that* John Z. Delorean.

One of the interesting features of the car was the engine. It was a 120 degree V-6 that was both water, and air cooled! The cylinder heads were cooled by air, while the cylinders themselves were water jacketed. This proved to be much too complicated system for production, so an all water cooled engine was called for. Even though the entire project was scrapped, the prototype engine still lives, at least as a

display. It resides today in the Porsche museum.
